All students should endeavour to attend the upcoming PUMA 2nd World Open (www.pumaworldopen.com) on 31st march & 1st April. £12.50 per day, or £20 for both, with special rates for families. This is a flagship event for PUMA and involves a tremendous organisational effort so please show your appreciation by attending this event. For tickets, please speak to your instructor.

PUMA is now introducing compulsory black belt training for all black belts aged 18+. Black belts aged 14-17 are welcome, but it is not compulsory. The aim is to ensure all black belts are maintain their training, and is a requisite for those wishing to grade. The sessions will be held 3-4 times a year, and it is expected that all black belts attend at least some every year. The first session will be at Thornbury Leisure Centre on Saturday 3rd March 2:15pm - 4:15pm, and each session will cost £7 per person.
